
To Whom It May Concern,

It is with great pleasure that I announce Officer Mike Cirrincione has been selected as Employee of the Month for July 2017.

Officer Cirrincione joined the department on May 29, 2012, and graduated Police Basic Training from the Illinois State Police Academy on August 30, 2012. During his tenure with the Quincy Police Department, he was selected as Employee of the Month for June 2014 and then the 2014 Employee of the Year, received the DUI Traffic Safety Award (for 2014), and received a certificate from Alliance Against Intoxicated Motorists for DUI arrests. In addition to his duties as a Patrol Officer, Officer Cirrincione is a Field Training Officer.

Officer Cirrincione was nominated for this award due to his actions on June 15, 2017. At approximately 2356 hours that date, while on patrol, Officer Cirrincione located a male subject lying on the ground near 6<sup>th</sup> & Spring. Officer Cirrincione got out with this subject to provide medical attention if needed and an ambulance was dispatched. While performing in this community caretaking role, Officer Cirrincione developed probable cause to arrest the subject for manufacture and delivery of cannabis. Shortly after this arrest, it was discovered that this male had also crashed his vehicle into a retaining wall at 11<sup>th</sup> & Oak and fled that scene on foot. Officer Cirrincione then performed standardized field sobriety testing and arrested the subject for DUI, leaving the scene of an accident, improper lane usage, and possession of a controlled substance. This subject was later lodged in the Adams County Jail on those charges. Due to Officer Cirrincione's keen awareness while on patrol, he was not only able to assist a subject with a possible medical emergency, but also to quickly catch the suspect in a DUI hit and run crash with additional drug charges.
