City Of Quincy Council Resolution Authorizing Washington Theater Façade Restoration. (Low bid from Rupp Masonry Construction Co. in the amount of \$9,660 with \$5,000 donated from Quincy Preserves and \$4,660 from Washington Theater maintenance funds.)
