

The following exterior features of the Blackstone Building, 237 North Sixth Street, are among those protected by City Ordinance No. 8974 approved March 11, 2003:

- (1) Prominent arched entry.
- (2) Limestone columns flanking entry.
- (3) Round arches over door and window openings.
- (4) Wood window frameworks.
- (5) Stone sills.
- (6) Radiating brick lintels.
- (7) Oriel window with pressed metal surround.
- (8) Prism glass in transom of south first story window on east façade.
- (9) Wood and metal cornice.
- (10) Rough-faced masonry walls.
- (11) Contrasting colors and textures.
- (12) Limestone string course over first story.
- (13) Iron guard rails in front of east window wells.
