#### RESOLUTIONS

City Of Quincy Council Resolution Authorizing Census Media Consultant Contract And Marketing Program. (Contract with Rethink Media to develop and operate the Census 2020 media program paid thru a grant by the Secretary of State.)

Central Services Director, the Utilities and Engineering Director, and the Central Services Committee recommending approval of the proposal from R.N.O.W., Inc., West Allis, WI, in the amount of \$411,782 for two (2) garbage trucks.
