Resolution requesting permission from IDOT to temporarily close the left lane of eastbound U.S. Route 24, a State Highway in the City of Quincy from 2nd and Maine to the Missouri State line and the left lane of westbound U.S. Route 24 in the City of Quincy from the west terminus of State Route 104 to the Missouri State Line and the right lane of North 3rd St. (U.S. Route 24/State Route 57) in the intersection of State Route 104, north 3rd (State Route 57) from Broadway to Maine and 4th (U.S. Route 24/State Route 57) from Jersey to Hampshire on May 19th, 2018 for the “Bridge The Gap To Health Race”, 5:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. (noon).
