### PETITIONS

**Ward 7** By the Salvation Army Kroc Center requesting permission to hold Halloween Fun Run/Walk on October 27<sup>th</sup> starting at 9:00 a.m. The run will start at the Kroc Center, go east on Vermont to 7<sup>th</sup>, south to Hampshire, west to 6<sup>th</sup> Street, north to Vermont and back to the Kroc Center.

**Wards 3,4** By Law Enforcement Torch Run for Special Olympics requesting permission to hold their run on June 12<sup>th</sup> beginning at 7:00 a.m. at Transition, 631 North 48<sup>th</sup>, running north to Columbus Road then East, leaving the city limits. A squad car will lead the runners and other vehicles with special markings will follow.

By the District requesting to conduct a raffle and have the bond requirement waived from June 8<sup>th</sup> to August 24<sup>th</sup>. The City Clerk recommends approval of the permit.
