Resolution Authorizing Execution And Amendment Of Section 5311 Grant Agreement. (Emergency Relief-Operating Assistance 100% Federal Share - CARES ACT in the amount of \$2,261,960 with non matching requirement from the City.)

Resolution Authorizing Execution And Amendment Of Section 5311 Grant Agreement. (Rural Grantees funding in the amount of \$600,253 subject to a match requirement from the City.)

Utilities and Engineering Director and Utilities Committee recommending approval of the invoice from Richards Electric in the amount of \$20,723.90 for Raw Water Pump #1 emergency repairs.
