## PETITIONS

**Ward 7**  
By the Dogwood 2017 Celebration Committee requesting the following streets be closed for the Dogwood Festival on May 5<sup>th</sup> from 1:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.: 5<sup>th</sup>, Maine to Hampshire; and on May 5<sup>th</sup> through May 7<sup>th</sup> from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.: Maine, 4<sup>th</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup>; 5<sup>th</sup> from north side of drive-thru lane of Mercantile Bank to Hampshire; and Hampshire, 4<sup>th</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup>, with the 5<sup>th</sup> & Hampshire intersection closing on a diagonal. They also request “No Parking” signs be posted on May 4<sup>th</sup> at the close of business with “No Parking” restriction beginning one hour prior to street closing time.

**Wards 3,4,7**  
By the Quincy Area Chamber of Commerce requesting permission to hold the Dogwood parade on May 6<sup>th</sup> beginning at 9:30 a.m. starting on Maine at 24<sup>th</sup>, going west to 6<sup>th</sup>, north and south on 6<sup>th</sup> then disbanding. Line up of the parade will begin at 7:00 a.m. on Maine, 24<sup>th</sup> to 36<sup>th</sup>. They request “No Parking” signs be placed on Maine, 6<sup>th</sup> to 36<sup>th</sup>, and 6<sup>th</sup>, Hampshire to Jersey, at the close of business on Friday, May 5<sup>th</sup>. Rain delays are planned for 11:30 a.m. or 1:30 p.m. as the committee deems necessary on Saturday, May 6<sup>th</sup>. Organizers will be responsible for clean-up of city streets after parade.

By QHS Class of 2017 All Night Party Committee holding their all night party on Friday, June 3<sup>rd</sup>, at the Scotties Fun Spot, 8000 Broadway beginning at 11:00 p.m. and ending at 5:00 a.m. They are requesting **Section 134.02 (Curfew)** be waived during the night to permit participants under the legal curfew age to return to their homes without incident.

By VFW Auxiliary of Illinois requesting permission to conduct a raffle and have the bond requirement waived from now through 9/15/17. The City Clerk recommends approval of the permit.

## REPORTS OF THE TRAFFIC COMMISSION

**Ward 1**  
Recommending parking be removed from Winsor Dr., North & South, at the east line of 13<sup>th</sup> St. extending 30 ft. east and at the west line of 14<sup>th</sup> St. extending 30 ft. west; Stone Creek Dr., North & South, at the east line of 13<sup>th</sup> St. extending 30 ft. east.; North 13<sup>th</sup> St., East & West, at the south line of Winsor Dr. extending 30 ft. south and East & West at the north line of Stone Creek Dr. 30 ft. north; North 14<sup>th</sup> St., East & West, at the south line of Winsor Dr. extending 30 ft. south.

**Ward 6**  
Recommending approval of a 4-Way Stop at the intersection of 14<sup>th</sup> and Washington Streets.

**Ward 2**  
Recommending approval that the alley located between Broadway and Spring Street, 5<sup>th</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> Streets, be made a “one-way” alley for westbound traffic only.

**Ward 1**  
Recommending approval of a “Yield” sign being placed at the intersection of Westwood Dr. and Wintergreen Dr., with eastbound traffic on Westwood Dr. yielding to Wintergreen Dr.

**Ward 3**  
Recommending approval of parking being removed along the east side of North 25<sup>th</sup> St., commencing at a point 160 ft. south of the center line of Spring St. and extending south a distance of 50 ft.

**Ward 4**  
Recommending approval that parking be removed along the east side of North 20<sup>th</sup> St., commencing at the center line of Hampshire St. and extending north along the east curb line a distance of 100 ft.

Resolution requesting permission from MODOT to temporarily close the north lane of eastbound U.S. Route 24, a State Highway in Marion County from the West end of Memorial Bridge to the Illinois State Line and the south lane of westbound U.S. Route 24, a State Highway in Marion County from the west end of Bayview Bridge to the Illinois State Line as above designated on May 20<sup>th</sup>, 2017 for the "Bridge The Gap To Health Race", 5:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. (noon).
