## **REGULAR MEETING**

Quincy, Illinois, April 24, 2017

The regular meeting of the City Council was held this day at 7:30 p.m. with Mayor Kyle A. Moore presiding.

WHEREAS, a proposal from Woody's Municipal Supply Company of Edwardsville, Illinois, offers the City the purchase of a Schwarze A9 Monsoon regenerative air sweeper demo unit at the price of \$220,000; and,

WHEREAS, funds for this purchase are available in the current fiscal year budget; now,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Director of Utilities and Engineering recommends to the Mayor and Quincy City Council that the proposal from Woody's Municipal Supply Company of Edwardsville, Illinois, in the amount of \$220,000 be accepted.
