

Combined Sewer Overflow - Phase 1 Improvements, City of Quincy

Upgrades to the City of Quincy's combined sewer system at various locations were financed by the Clean Water State Revolving Fund (SRF). The SRF program is administered by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and receives a portion of its money to fund these types of projects from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.

This project includes replacement of combined sewage diversion structures and other improvements to minimize the volume of combined sewage discharged to local surface waters. Once complete, it will improve water quality for Adams County residents and those downstream.

SRF programs operate in each state to provide communities the resources necessary to build, maintain, and improve the infrastructure that protects one of our most valuable resources: water.
