QUINCY REGIONAL-BALDWIN FIELD

ABOUT THE AIRPORT

Quincy Regional Airport - Baldwin Field (UIN) is a commercial service airport in west-central Illinois in Adams County along the Mississippi River. UIN is located approximately 12 miles east of the City of Quincy and is owned by the City of Quincy. UIN offers daily commercial flights to Chicago O'Hare International (ORD) and St. Louis-Lambert International (STL) which connects travelers to various domestic and international locations. The Airport supports daily recreational flying activities, aircraft flight testing, and corporate/business flying. The Airport connects businesses in the region, which include manufacturing, distribution, and medicine to markets across the U.S. UIN also supports the community through partnering with Quincy University, hosting the Southern Illinois University Motorcycle Rider Program, and by providing frequent educational tours of the airport and AirUSA museum.

- Quincy has repaired or replaced

The Human Resources Department & City Council helped to successfully reduce the City's Health Insurance costs by approximately \$500,000 without any change of coverage or costs to employees or their dependants.


