#### **PETITION**

The City Clerk recommends approval of the permits.

#### RESOLUTIONS

Quincy Transit Lines Director and the Director of Administrative Services recommending approval of a short-term loan of up to \$600,000, as needed, from the Cash Reserve Fund to the Quincy Transit Lines to pay operating expenses.

Director of Public Works recommending approval to enter into a five-year contract with Epic io, Fort Mill, SC in the amount of \$51,300.00 for 24-hour analytical video surveillance services at the recycling drop-off locations.
