







Construction of various improvement to expand the treatment capacity of the Quincy Wastewater Treatment Plant located at 700 West Lock & Dam Road were financed by the Clean Water State Revolving Fund (SRF). The SRF program is administered by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and receives a portion of its money to fund these types of projects from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. This project includes replacement of three (3) raw sewage pumps and refurbishing six (6) effluent pumps; construction of a parallel effluent pipeline; construction of raw sewage flow control devices; and construction of floatable material capture systems at three (3) combined sewer overflow outfalls. Once complete, it will improve water quality for Quincy area residents and businesses and Mississippi River communities downstream of Lock & Dam 21. SRF programs operate in each state to provide communities the resources necessary to build, maintain, and improve the infrastructure that protects one of our most valuable resources: water.
