PUBLIC COMMENT

PETITIONS

By St. Francis Solanus Church requesting permission to conduct a raffle and have the bond requirement waived from April 12, 2024, through June 8, 2024. The City Clerk recommends approval of the permit.

By the VFW Post 5129/Rotary requesting permission to have a "Poppies" drive at various locations on March 2nd, 3rd and May 25th.

Ward 7 Special Event Application from Scott Moore of the Early Childhood and Family Center, 401 South 8th Street, requesting permission to hold its annual student parade in recognition of the "Week of the Young Child" at 10:00 a.m. and 1:15 p.m. on Monday, April 8, 2024. He requests the closure of 8th Street, Kentucky to State Streets; 9th Street, Kentucky to State Streets; Kentucky Street, 8th to 9th Streets and State Street, 8th to 9th Streets for approximately twenty-five (25) minutes for each parade and the City provide barricades and assist with closing the intersections. The applicant has submitted all required documentation and approval is recommended by the Department of Utilities & Engineering.
