PUBLIC COMMENT

PETITIONS

Ward 7 An application for Waiver of Liquor Ordinances by the Quincy Metropolitan Exposition Auditorium & Office Building (Oakley Lindsey Civic Center) requesting permission to have liquor ordinance for Closing Hours waived to be able to serve liquor until 2:30 a.m. for a pool tournament from March 12th to 17th. The Quincy Police Department has given their approval.

Ward 4 An application for Revocable Permit for Encroachment of City Right-of-Way from Todd Stapleton, owner of 723 South 22nd St., requesting permission to place a large pod container on the street in front of his residence pending the sale of his property. The Engineering Manager presents this request subject to six conditions.

Ward 7 Special Event Application from Dr. Orville Jones of First Baptist Church requesting permission to hold the **Juneteenth Community Celebration 2024** on Friday, June 14th through Sunday, June 16th from 11:00 a.m. until 9:30 p.m. in Washington Park. Closure of Maine St., 4th to 5th Streets and 5th St., Maine to Hampshire Streets and the City provide barricades for street closures are requested. Notification of all business owners and residents of the street closures on North 5th St. and Maine St. is required. A Live Entertainment/Public Gathering License and a Petting Zoo Permit, to be located on North 5th St. near Hampshire St., have been approved. A large tent and stage on Park District property will be erected and are approved pending an inspection prior to the start of the event. All required documentation has been submitted and approval is recommended by the Department of Utilities & Engineering.

Wards 3,4 Special Event Application from the Quincy Public Schools Foundation Broad of Trustees requesting permission to hold the **11th Annual Dream Big Color Fun Run** on Saturday, April 20, 2024. The 5K (3.29 mile) run/walk will begin and end at Quincy Senior High School at 3322 Maine St. Street closures, which are Maine St., 16th to 33rd Streets; 16th St., Maine to Jersey Streets; Jersey St., 16th St. to East Avenue; East Ave; York St., East Ave. to 23rd St.; 23rd St., York to Maine Streets, are requested from 8:30 a.m. until 11:00 a.m. with barricades. "No Parking" signs are requested along the race route by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, April 19th. Auxiliary Police Officers are requested to assist with traffic control at the intersections of 24th and Maine St. and 30th and Maine St. Business owners and residents along the event route will be notified of the street closures at least thirty (30) days prior to the event. All required documentation has been submitted and approval is recommended by the Department of Utilities & Engineering.
